Myself and my in-house supplier have been able to constantly develop the standardization of the product as well as continuously expand our product range. We have achieved this by using modern machinery, automatic systems, the relevant product processes and the necessary technical measures.

2 Standards

2.1 Unshelled Hazelnuts are exclusively processed according to the Turkish standard norm TS 3074 and TS EN ISO 9000 quality.

2.2 Shelled hazelnuts are exclusively processed according to the Turkish standard norm TS 3074 and TS EN ISO 9000 quality.

2.3 Hazelnut flour, **natural** and **roasted** is exclusively processed according to the Turkish standard norm TS 1917.

3 Quality

Hazelnuts are divided according to their quality as defined in the 3 classes below (the euro standards):

3.1 Extra class:

Hazelnuts in this class are of superior quality, screened and calibrated. They are of normal shape and conform to commercial type or variety.

3.2 Class I:

Hazelnuts in this class are of high quality, screened and calibrated. However, they could have minor defects.

The minimum size for a shelled hazelnut from the extra class and class 1 is 9mm. However, the Piccolo type hazelnut, or nut of similar description type has an approved diameter of 6-9mm.

3.3 Class II:

This class includes hazelnuts which cannot be categorized in the superior classes, but conform to the defined minimum requirements.

3.4 Minimum requirements for hazelnuts:

Hazelnuts must conform to the following criteria:

1. dry, moisture content is not allowed to be more than 6 %.
2. clean, in particular free of any visible foreign substances.
3. free of imperfections which make them inedible.
4. healthy.
5. free of mold, decay and visible spoilage from insects. Free of insects, dead or alive, or any other vermin, dead or alive. Not rotten and free of any foreign smell or taste.
6. whole nuts.

Finally, hazelnuts are not considered defect if a part of the hazelnut shell is missing, or if the internal hazelnut itself has been damaged by no more than 3 mm in width and 1.5mm in depth. Hazelnuts which are not whole and where more than 1/3 of the nut is missing are considered nut pieces.

9 Pricing policy

On principle, for marketable assets, in this case hazelnuts, the trading cost within the black sea region is the market price. The market price is the average price at which hazelnuts of a specific type and quality are sold. The trading cost is generally the stock exchange value or market value.
